Directions:

- 1. Attend a professional, high school, or college instrumental performance.
- 2. Write two or three paragraphs to describe the concert. (No more than one page typed.)

Include the following:

- 1. The name of the ensemble performing
- 2. Titles of the pieces being performed
- 3. The location of the event
- 4. Style/Genre of music
- 5. Your opinion of the music you heard
 - Did you like the music?
 - Was it performed well?
 - What made it a quality performance?...or, How was the performance lacking in quality?
 - Use musical terminology to describe the music (e.g. tone, balance, blend, control, melody, harmony, solo, precision, style, dynamics, articulation, phrasing, expression, tempo, rhythm, pitch, intonation.)
- 3. Place the written review in Mr. Messick's "In Box" (located on his office door) before the last day of each quarter.
